

# BOLTON FOOTBALL 2011

Welcome to Bolton Football! We are the Bolton Touchdown Club and we provide support for our Bolton Wildcats. There are no fees to pay to become a member. Participation and an interest in your son's and the other Wildcats best interest are all that is needed. We invite **all** to become involved, volunteer and to serve. There is something for everyone to do. Some things that we **are not** are the complaint department for playing time, coaching staff and general unhappiness. These things should all be taken up with the head coach of our Wildcats, Tommy Miller. Some things that **we do are** motivate and back our players and coaches by attending all games away and at home. At home we are the host providing food at concessions stands, manning the press booth, selling spirit wear, moving chains, and cheering on our Wildcats. When not attending games we are working hard at raising money to provide playing equipment, weight training equipment, camp experiences; supplementing the coaches' salaries; drinks and fruit during two a days and most any thing else that is needed. We also are a source of volunteer support for our middle school football program which directly feeds into Bolton High School. Jay Ward (268-5431) runs this program and they play at Bolton on Tuesday nights. We also invite the Middle School parents to participate as members of the Touchdown Club.

**Remember the coaches provide the experience and we provide the support.** Nothing makes your child feel more cared for or more important than seeing their parent actively participating at their school (no matter what they tell you.) Some ways you can become involved are listed below.

**Volunteer for helping in the concession stand during any home game.**

**Volunteer to help run the clock, spot and move chains during any home game.**

**Sale Boston Butts during our annual Super Bowl fundraiser.**

**Volunteer to bring Gatorade to the games for the players after each game.**

**Purchase and use a reloadable Kroger gift card or Schnuck's card.**

**Purchase spirit wear at registration August 2<sup>nd</sup>, Club Meetings and all home games.**

## **Player's Fee**

Player's fees can be made at this time and are **due by the mandatory meeting, Tuesday Aug 9<sup>th</sup>**. After the Aug 9<sup>th</sup> meeting fees will go to \$120.00. Let's get this taken care of quickly.

Fee payment is payable as follows:

- \$100 payable now through the mandatory meeting
- \$120 if paid after mandatory meeting

How to make payment:

1. Checks made out to "Bolton Touchdown Club" or cash should be placed **in an envelope with the players name and amount**

- printed on the outside. All fees should be given to Coach Miller for varsity players and Coach Williams for freshman players.
2. You can sell banners to help satisfy your fees. A form is attached.
    - By selling one field banner for \$200/\$250 you can receive credit of \$50 toward your player's fee.
  3. If a payment plan needs to be worked out, please see one of our officers.

### **Field Banners**

Field Banners are sold each year as a fund raiser. This is also a good way for business owners to advertise. We have approximately 2000 people in attendance at each varsity game. These banners for first time participants are \$200 for 1 color lettering or \$250 for 2 color lettering for the season. Next year renewal participants are \$100/\$125. This fund raiser could be extremely successful if everyone would participate and ask perhaps the businesses that they frequent. In order for the banner to be ready for the first game, the last day to turn in a banner sale and money is Tuesday, Aug 9<sup>th</sup>. ### **MOST CRUCIAL IMMEDIATE NEEDS:**

#### **Volunteers for Games**

At the mandatory meeting on Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup> there will be volunteer sign-up posters for all home games. There are MANY volunteer slots available that need to be filled. **We need volunteers for chains, concessions, grill, clock, and spotters.** Everyone wants to see their child play so please volunteer on a night when your child won't be playing. For example freshmen parents should volunteer for Varsity, JV or middle school game nights while Varsity parents should be signing up for freshmen and middle school game nights. Please make sure you volunteer.

#### **Gatorade Parents**

For every game we provide Gatorade after the game (home and away.) We need a Varsity parent to purchase, chill and serve at each Varsity game, a freshmen parent to do each freshman game and a Jr. Varsity parent to do the same for Jr. Varsity games. ### **FUNDRAISERS**

#### **Wildcat Gold Cards**

Another large fundraiser is Gold card sales, it is run by the coaches. We have made anywhere from \$5000-\$9,000 on this fundraiser. Cards with discounts to various local stores and restaurants will be given to your player for them to sell for \$20 each. The team keeps half the profits. Each player is given 20 cards to start; the event culminates with a team sales blitz on Saturday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. There are cash prizes for the players.

#### **Boston Butt Sale**

Super Bowl weekend, (2/3/12-2/5/12) we will have our annual Boston Butt fundraiser. (Date is contingent upon the 2011 NFL season being played out due to labor issues between league owners and players). We will be using the same Memphis in May award

winning team to do the cooking. We plan on selling many more this year and doubling our earnings. This will take full participation of all members and requires a lot of selling. More details later.

### **Kroger Gift Cards**

Purchase a reloadable Kroger gift card for \$5 at any booster meeting. The cards come preloaded with \$5; all you need to do is add money before you buy groceries or gas. Kroger will donate 5% of all purchases made with your gift card; once we reach \$5,000 collectively they send the club a check.
